

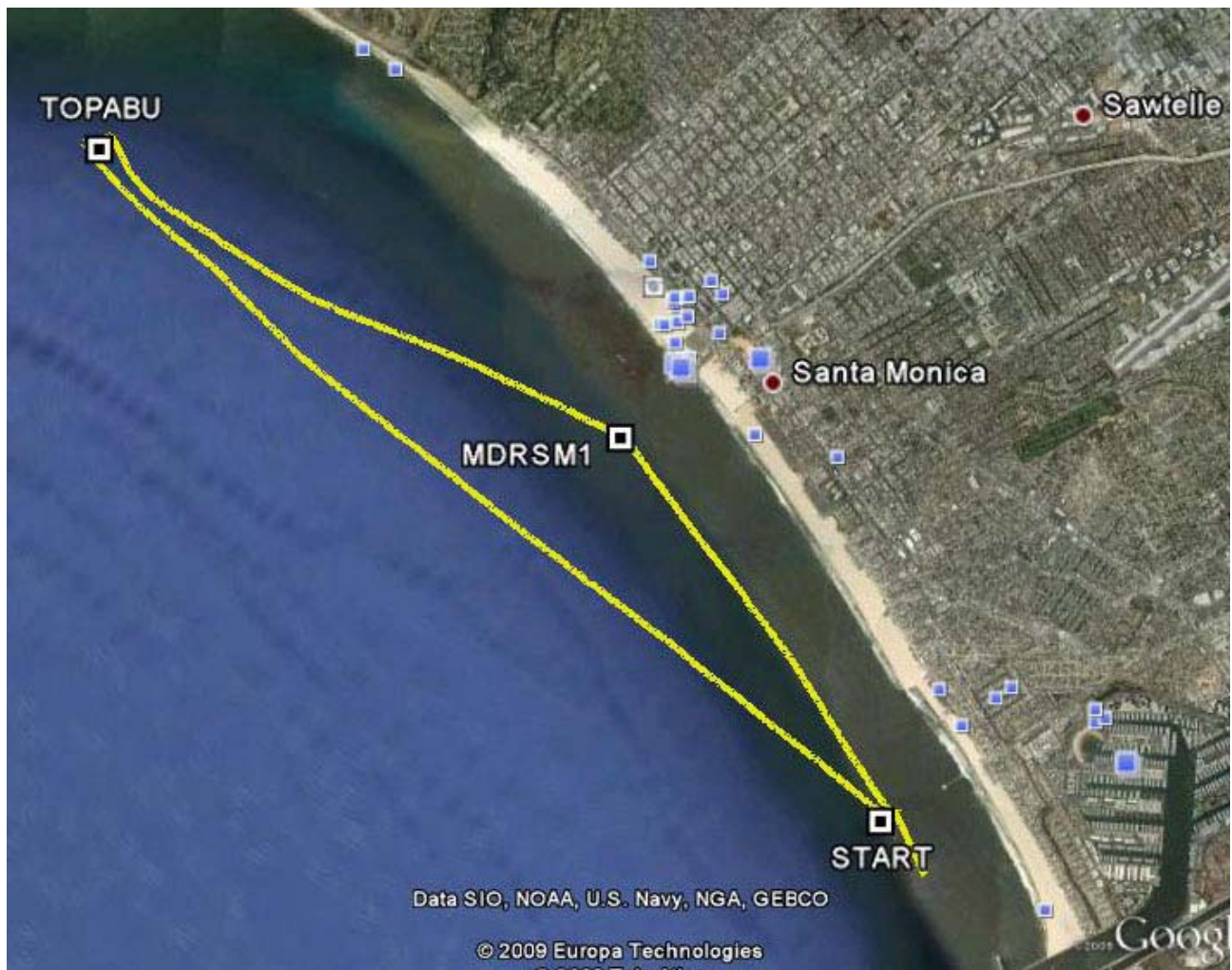
## Summer Series Race: August 15, 2009

The 2009 SFVYC Summer Series Race was a 10.2 nautical mile romp from Venice Pier to the Topanga Buoys, back to the Santa Monica Buoy, and then finishing back at the Pier. Bruce Warner was the PRO and did a great job laying out the course and running the race. The 11 boats started the race under an overcast sky and about 6 knots of wind. Toward the end of the race, Turn Key saw 11 knots on the gauges. Glenn Van Heel, sailing Ray's Problem Child finished first on corrected time, followed closely by John Duthie, 7 seconds behind in another Holder 20. The post-race party was again held at the South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club, who provided great food and hospitality.
